Any and all Trust Service Providers and trust services that are currently on the trusted list have been included in accordance with the relevant provisions laid down in Regulation (EU) No 910/2014, its secondary legislation and the Croatian implementing act. Any new Trust Service Providers and/or trust services may be included on the trusted list in accordance with the relevant provisions laid down in Regulation (EU) No 910/2014, its secondary legislation and the Croatian implementing act.

Supervisory scheme information

The legal basis for the supervisory activities are Regulation (EU) No 910/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 July 2014 on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market and repealing Directive 1999/93/EC,

Implementing body

The Ministry of Justice, Public Administration and Digital Transformation (MPUDT) is the competent authority responsible for the implementation of Regulation (EU) No 910/2014 (eIDAS) and the national Act on the Implementation of the eIDAS Regulation in the Republic of Croatia.

The Ministry performs the following supervisory functions:

- Supervision of trust service providers, granting and revoking qualified status.
- Analysis of compliance assessment reports and conducting audits of trust service providers.
- Management and publication of the Trusted List of trust service providers in the Republic of Croatia.
- Cooperation with supervisory bodies of other EU Member States regarding the implementation of the eIDAS Regulation.
- Reporting to the European Commission on the state of trust services and supervision activities.

The Service for digital identity is the organizational unit of the Ministry of Justice, Public Administration and Digital Transformation, designated as the contact point for all matters regarding trust services, supervision, and the trust list.
